

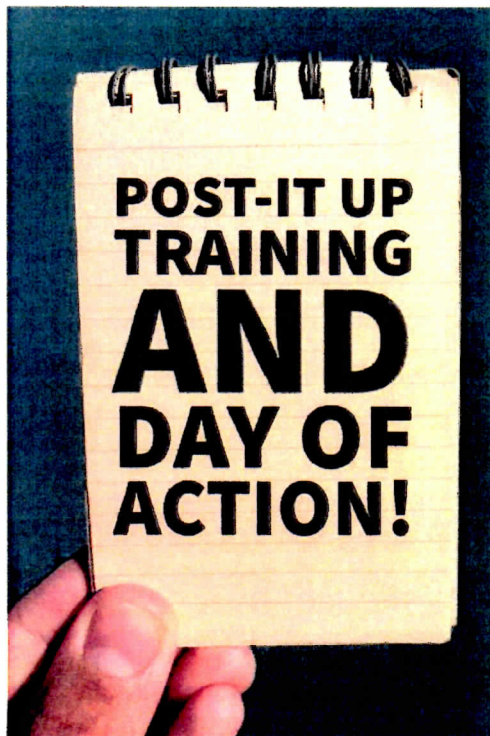
“Post-It Up” Training and Day of Community Action

Join the Episcopal Diocese of Atlanta’s Commission on Domestic Minor Sex Trafficking as we host a **“Post-It Up” Training and Day of Community Action**. Pamela Perkins Carn from Interfaith Children’s Movement in Atlanta, Ga will be here to lead us.

“Post-It Up” is a critical mass campaign to accelerate the postings of signs required by state law, mandating the cooperation of certain businesses throughout our city and our state. The signs simply list a hotline number victims of trafficking can call for help.

This is an urgent and time sensitive, tactical call to action.

Volunteers will receive training and education related to human trafficking in our state, as well as go out in small groups to encourage businesses to post the signs.
